You will only need to bring on tour the items in the list below. Please have these items ready in a tote, draw-bag or daypack, separate from your main luggage.</i></p> <p><i>If you are returning to the same accommodation supplier after your tour, they can generally look after your main luggage. Waterproof Jacket – Gore-tex or similar	
Waterproof Trousers [lightweight is ok]	
Socks 2 – 3 Pairs

Swimming Costume & Lightweight Towel [microfiber best]

2 x Lightweight Long Sleeved Shirts	
Lightweight Walking Trousers	
Shorts	
Sunhat with brim	
For Cold Weather	
Long Sleeved Thermal top	
Thermal Long Johns [optional]	
Gloves [optional]	
Beanie [recommended as nights can get cold]	
Fleece Jacket or Down Jacket	
Footwear	
Boots or Trail Runners [boots are better but not essential]	
Camp Shoes - crocks or sandals [not recommended for walking]	
Personal Items	
Sunglasses, sunscreen & balm, hand sanitiser, camera, wet wipes	
Toiletries, Medications, Spare drink bottle, walking poles [optional]	
Phones & Money – there is limited reception on the island with Telstra and there are promotional items that you can purchase [optional]
